This beautiful boat, a 67ft cruiser stern narrowboat built in 1995 by the highly respected Graham Reeves, is a wonderfully presented vessel that combines proven craftsmanship with thoughtful modern updates. Tastefully redecorated throughout, she benefits from new flooring and an impressive amount of built-in storage, creating a bright, practical, and comfortable living space. Recent improvements include additional wardrobe space, while the exterior was fully repainted in 2024, giving her a fresh and well-cared-for finish. She was blacked in 2022, holds a Boat Safety Certificate valid until 2027, and benefited from a survey in 2023, offering reassurance and peace of mind.

The galley is both functional and inviting, fitted with attractive rosewood worktops, a sink, a three-ring gas hob, and a separate oven and grill. A 12v fridge/freezer and generous cupboard storage make this a practical space for everyday living. The breakfast bar in the kitchen is an added benefit, providing a relaxed and sociable area for dining, entertaining, or enjoying a morning coffee while taking in the view, and enhancing the overall flow of the living space.

Accommodation comfortably sleeps four people. The second cabin offers two single beds with useful storage underneath, while the main bedroom features a small double bed with wardrobe space positioned at the rear and additional drawers beneath, making excellent use of space. The bathroom is well equipped with a shower and hip bath, pump-out toilet, sink, and vanity unit with an overhead mirrored cupboard. A duck hatch along the hallway allows natural light and ventilation to flow through the boat, adding to the sense of space throughout.

Powered by a reliable Isuzu 40hp engine paired with a PRM150 gearbox, this narrowboat is well suited to cruising the inland waterways with confidence. With a practical layout running from stern to bow through the twin bedroom, storage corridor, main bedroom, bathroom, dining area, galley, and saloon, this is a versatile and welcoming boat, ideal for holidays, extended cruising, or full-time living afloat.
