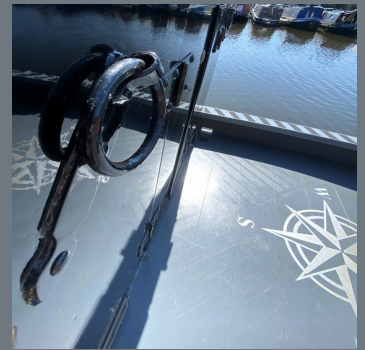

From its stretched Joshua bow to its rivet detailing and Northwich Trader-style lines, Beck's is a visual celebration of canal boating history, with recessed panels and a traditional aesthetic that turns heads wherever she cruises. The thoughtfully designed layout, from stern to bow, comprises a charming boatman's cabin, practical engine room, luxurious bathroom, fully-equipped galley with breakfast bar, and a spacious saloon. Whether you're enjoying a slow cruise or moored up for an extended stay, Beck's delivers both comfort and style in abundance. Inside, the interior echoes rustic cottage charm with a crisp modern finish. A neutral cream colour palette is complemented by warm wooden accents, reclaimed timber features, and soft lighting, creating a calm and elegant space. Underfloor central heating and a solid fuel stove ensure warmth throughout the seasons, making Beck's a year-round home or holiday escape. The galley is a culinary haven, boasting a Belfast sink, full-size freestanding cooker, fridge with freezer box, washing machine, and solid wood worktops. A stylish breakfast bar with two stools offers a relaxed dining space that transitions effortlessly into the saloon. The saloon is a bright and inviting space, featuring a comfortable 3-seater

The bathroom is a luxurious retreat, featuring a freestanding roll-top bath with shower over, grey tile surrounds, a macerator pump-out toilet, and a vanity unit with generous storage. It’s a true sanctuary after a day of cruising. Beck’s accommodates up to six people across its smartly arranged berths. The boatman’s cabin has been cleverly converted into two child-sized single beds with storage, while the master bedroom offers a full-sized double bed, a large wardrobe, and additional storage for comfortable liveaboard use or extended cruising. Under the hood, Beck’s is as capable as she is beautiful. Powered by a reliable Beta Marine 50hp engine paired with a PRM 260 gearbox, and featuring Victron electrical systems and solar panels, this boat ensures efficient, smooth cruises...
