With both bow and stern hydraulic thrusters, navigating even the tightest moorings becomes effortless, all controlled from the comfort of the stylish wheelhouse. A standout feature is the dedicated engine room at the stern, housing a powerful Vetus 114bhp engine, a robust 3000W inverter, eight domestic batteries, and two starter batteries—ensuring both reliability and peace of mind on longer cruises.

Accessibility is a key strength of Freya, with a built-in electric lift and ramps offering easy boarding for wheelchair users or those with limited mobility, making this an ideal boat for inclusive living or travel. Inside, the space is cleverly designed and beautifully finished, offering both luxury and practicality throughout.

The galley is a joy to cook in, featuring a charming Heritage Compact Duette range, undercounter fridge and freezer, and gleaming black starlight quartz countertops. It flows seamlessly into the open-plan lounge, where a fold-out dining table with four chairs provides the perfect spot for meals or entertaining. A Morso Squirrel 4.5kW stove creates a cosy atmosphere, complemented by a handsome dresser unit that adds warmth and character to the space.

The master bedroom is a true retreat, offering a fixed king-sized bed surrounded by an abundance of storage. With two wardrobes, multiple drawers, and underbed cabinets, there's room for everything you need to live comfortably aboard. Black starlight quartz surfaces continue the theme of quiet luxury, while a bow window with a pull-down mesh fly screen invites in fresh air and natural light.

The bathroom is spacious and well-appointed, accessed through a sliding door for ease of movement. It features a large P-shaped shower measuring 900x1400mm—designed with accessibility in mind—alongside a cassette toilet and plenty of cupboard space for towels and essentials.
