Cornucopia is a beautifully appointed 57ft traditional narrowboat, built in 2009 with a Jonathan Wilson hull and fitted out by Louis & Joshua. Offering a practical and comfortable 2+2 berth layout, this well-designed boat is ideal for leisurely cruising, extended stays, or life afloat with all the comforts of home.

Entering from the stern, you'll find a welcoming bedroom featuring a double bed with storage beneath, along with a wardrobe, cupboards, radiator, and charming porthole windows that enhance the traditional narrowboat feel.

Moving forward, the bathroom is well equipped with a shower enclosure, wash basin with vanity unit, Sealand Dometic pump-out toilet, heated towel rail, as well as useful cupboard and shelf storage.

The galley offers everything needed for day-to-day living aboard, including a Belling oven, grill and 4 burner gas hob, fridge, sink and drainer, generous work surfaces, wine rack, cupboards, and drawers. A nearby breakfast bar with two stools creates a practical dining space without compromising the open feel of the interior.

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At the bow, the saloon is a cosy and inviting place to relax, complete with a sofa bed for additional guests, shelves, cupboards, a Bubble solid fuel stove, JVC radio, and a water tank capacity gauge. Porthole windows continue the boat's traditional character, while the bow doors open out to provide easy access and a pleasant connection to the outside space.
