The interior layout has been thoughtfully arranged, running from stern to bow with a generous main bedroom, a second bedroom, bathroom, galley kitchen, and comfortable lounge area. The main bedroom features a double bed with bedside drawers, a large chest of drawers for storage, and a Water Freedom system. The second cabin contains practical bunk beds with a ladder, making excellent use of the available space.

The galley is well equipped with under-counter cupboards, a traditional butler sink, a freestanding gas oven with four-ring hob, and a 12V refrigerator, providing everything needed for extended stays aboard.

The bathroom comprises a pump-out toilet, wash basin, and shower with curtain, offering all essential facilities in a compact and

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practical layout.

Power is provided by a reliable 45hp Nanni diesel engine, making Etta well suited for leisurely cruising and exploration of the waterways.
