Designed in a sought-after reverse layout, this stunning boat feels every bit like a floating apartment, combining contemporary style with practical, high-spec features throughout. Finished with a new and improved two-pack Epifanes external paint coating, it offers enhanced durability and longevity, ensuring it looks as impressive for years to come as it does today. To the stern, a full pram cover with upholstered wraparound seating provides the perfect social space, comfortably accommodating 8+ people, ideal for entertaining or relaxing on the water. Stepping inside, the beautifully appointed galley is both stylish and highly functional, featuring white granite worktops with a matching breakfast bar, a Belfast sink with mixer tap, and a full suite of integrated appliances including a full-size washer/dryer, separate fridge and freezer, dishwasher, wine cooler, and a four-burner hob with separate oven and grill. Generous high and low-level cupboards and drawers ensure there is no shortage of storage, making this a true liveaboard-ready kitchen. The saloon is bright, spacious, and designed for comfort, with a large sofa that easily converts into an additional double berth, offering flexible accommodation for guests. A Morso solid fuel stove provides a cosy focal point, complemented by a large skylight that floods the space with natural light. Entertainment is well catered for with a 40" LG

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Smart TV and Panasonic theatre soundbar, while ample room remains for additional freestanding furniture. Thoughtfully designed shelving and storage cupboards add both practicality and style. Moving forward, the bathroom continues the theme of luxury, boasting a generous double-size glazed shower, twin wash basins, a ceramic pump-out toilet, and plenty of storage for everyday essentials. At the bow, the master bedroom provides a peaceful retreat, complete with a full-size double bed, bedside units, and an impressive range of floor-to-ceiling mirrored wardrobes. A large dressing table and additional cupboards and drawers enhance the sense of space and practicality, while glazed hardwood doors lead out onto the well deck, perfect for enjoying quiet mornings or evening sunsets.
