Description

Packed with charm, colour and character, Jaynar is a beautifully traditional 50ft Traditional Stern narrowboat built by Calcutt Boats in 1990. Full of warmth and personality, this well-presented vessel combines classic canal boat styling with practical liveaboard comfort, making her ideal for leisurely cruising or extended stays afloat.

Stepping inside, the cosy wood-lined interior creates an inviting atmosphere throughout, complemented by an impressive heating setup including underfloor heating, a multifuel stove with back boiler, hot water heater, and thoughtful touches that make life aboard comfortable all year round. Her traditional layout flows naturally from stern to bow, offering well-proportioned living spaces with plenty of storage throughout.

The galley is both practical and well-equipped, featuring a stainless steel sink and drainer, Hotpoint oven and grill with four burner gas hob, Electrolux fridge, Candy microwave, ample cupboard and drawer space, and integrated wine rack storage.

The saloon provides a relaxing and sociable living area with a sofa bed and pouffe, entertainment unit and shelving, along with the

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charming multifuel stove forming a cosy focal point for evenings aboard.

The master bedroom offers a comfortable double bed with storage beneath and overhead cupboards, complemented by additional shelving and under gunwale lighting which adds warmth and character to the cabin space.

The bathroom is fitted with a Thetford cassette toilet and shower, providing all the essentials for comfortable onboard living.

Built and fitted out by the respected Calcutt Boats, Jaynar is a characterful and welcoming narrowboat that offers traditional canal living with comfort, practicality and undeniable charm.
