John D is a well-maintained 46ft semi-traditional narrowboat built by John White Boatbuilders in 2001, offering a practical and comfortable setup ideal for continuous cruising or extended stays aboard. Thoughtfully upgraded over the years, she combines traditional charm with modern improvements, making her a solid and reliable choice for those looking to enjoy life on the waterways.

Powered by a Thornycroft engine, last serviced in November 2025, John D has been well cared for mechanically. She was last blacked in May 2023 and benefits from a valid BSS certificate through to February 2027, providing peace of mind for her next owner. Designed with off-grid living in mind, she features two large solar panels and a Kabola diesel stove, offering efficient, constant onboard heating throughout the seasons.

The interior has been tastefully updated, including a bespoke solid wood galley fitted in 2021. This well-designed kitchen space includes under-counter cupboards, a sink with drainer, freestanding oven, and an instant gas hot water boiler, all complemented by

a sliding hatch window that brings in light and fresh air. Herringbone flooring runs throughout the boat, adding a stylish and contemporary finish.

The saloon offers a cosy yet functional living area with a comfortable two-seater sofa and the Kabola diesel stove forming a warm focal point—perfect for relaxing after a day’s cruising.

The bedroom provides a comfortable double bed with useful storage beneath, along with a hanging rail for clothing, creating a practical and uncluttered space.

The bathroom is well laid out and includes a hip bath with overhead shower, wash basin, and a compost toilet, offering flexibility and independence for off-grid living.
