Clever storage solutions, including a tall cupboard, bookcase and under-seat compartments, ensure the space remains both functional and uncluttered, while a TV point adds to the onboard comfort.

The galley is well-appointed and designed with practicality in mind. It features a 12v fridge, sink with draining board, gas hob with three burners, oven and grill, along with ample cupboards and drawers for storage. Extractor ventilation and well-organised workspace make this a highly usable kitchen whether for short trips or extended stays aboard.
