The bathroom rivals any high-end home with its full-size walk-in shower, complemented by an extractor fan and a whale gulper pump. A washing machine, sink with vanity unit, and low-level composite shower tray add functionality, while a Jabsco deluxe electric toilet rounds out the amenities.

Autumn is powered by a robust Canaline 52hp engine paired with a PRM 150 gearbox, and navigational ease is ensured by a Vetus 95kg bowthruster. The vessel's utility systems are equally impressive, featuring a 12V and 240V electrical setup with a Sterling procombi inverter and a generous 1300kw solar panel array.
