Description

Memory Maker is a charming and compact 32' cruiser stern narrowboat that has been significantly upgraded and meticulously maintained by the current owner. Built in 1994 by Colliery Narrowboat Co Ltd, the boat recently benefitted from an extensive hull refurbishment carried out by Aqueduct Marina's specialist workshop, costing in excess of £10,600. This work included the installation of a brand-new 6mm base plate, pit welding to the hull sides where required, followed by grit blasting and the application of a durable two-pack epoxy coating up to the gunwales. To complement the hull work, the superstructure including the gunwales, roof and cabin sides was also stripped back to bare metal and professionally repainted. As a result, Memory Maker presents in excellent condition both above and below the waterline. With comfortable accommodation for up to four people, a modernised bathroom, and a reliable Beta Marine engine with a new gearbox fitted in 2026, this boat is perfectly suited for weekend escapes, holidays on the waterways, or those looking for an easy-to-manage first boat. The bathroom was completely refitted in 2025 and offers a modern and fresh space within the boat. It features a fully enclosed shower with hinged glazed doors, allowing for comfortable use while cruising or moored. A cassette toilet (Porta Potti) provides a simple and practical solution for onboard sanitation. A wash basin set within a vanity unit offers useful storage underneath for toiletries and essentials, ensuring the

bathroom remains tidy and functional. The recent refurbishment means this space feels bright, clean and ready for immediate use. The galley is thoughtfully designed to provide all the essentials for comfortable onboard cooking while making efficient use of space. It features a black composite sink and drainer with a mixer tap, along with an integrated four-burner gas hob and a separate oven and grill. A 12-volt fridge with freezer compartment keeps food and drinks chilled while cruising. Generous worktop space and a good range of cupboards ensure there is plenty of storage for cookware and provisions. Upholstered bench seating provides a practical and comfortable area that can easily convert into either a single or double berth when required. Storage cupboards and wardrobes on both the port and starboard sides provide convenient space for clothing and personal belongings.
