Description

Mithrandir is a beautifully maintained 55ft semi-traditional narrowboat, built and fitted out by the highly respected Colecraft, and offers a timeless blend of traditional character and thoughtful modern updates. Dating from 1990, she has clearly been well cared for and presents as a warm, inviting boat ideally suited to relaxed cruising, comfortable holidays, or longer periods spent living aboard. Her classic semi-trad stern provides a sociable yet sheltered cruising position, while the overall proportions make her easy to handle on the inland waterways. Stepping inside, the traditional stern-to-bow layout creates a natural and practical flow through the boat. The aft bedroom is designed with cruising in mind, featuring a 4'6" trundle bed that allows easy access to the stern when underway. Storage is well considered, with a fitted wardrobe and chest of drawers providing ample space for clothing and personal items, making this cabin both comfortable and functional. Moving forward, the recently renovated bathroom is fresh and contemporary, with a generous 700 x 800mm shower, a neatly positioned corner basin, and a Thetford cassette toilet. The galley has been newly fitted and is both stylish and practical, featuring attractive wooden block worktops and under-counter cupboards for storage. A 12-volt fridge and LPG instant water heater ensure everyday convenience, while a clever folding breakfast bar with collapsible

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chairs provides a flexible dining solution without encroaching on the living space. This is a galley designed to be used and enjoyed, whether for quick meals or leisurely cooking on board. At the bow, the saloon offers a welcoming retreat, centred around a 4.5kW multi-fuel stove that brings warmth and character throughout the cooler months. Comfortable seating, including a three-seater sofa and armchair, creates a cosy space for relaxing, entertaining, or simply watching the world go by from the towpath. The overall atmosphere is one of comfort and understated charm. Powered by a reliable Thornycroft T80 engine with a PRM Delta gearbox, Mithrandir is well equipped for dependable cruising. Her hull, built to a solid 8mm, 6mm, 4mm specification, was last surveyed in 2021, offering reassurance in her structural condition. With a generous 400-litre water capacity provided by twin bladder tanks, she is well set up for extended tim...
