Recently retired from a gentle life in seasonal hire, she has seen only light use and has been well maintained throughout her service. Presented in good overall condition, Mustang Sally comes with a brand new Boat Safety Scheme (BSS) certificate, was freshly blacked in July 2025 using durable Jotun 2-pack epoxy coating, and benefits from the installation of a brand new PRM 260 gearbox in October 2025 – a recent upgrade worth approximately £3,500. With her reliable Barrus Shire 40hp engine and thoughtful layout, she's ready to set off on new adventures with her next owner.

Inside, Mustang Sally is both practical and inviting, offering a layout designed for comfort and flexibility. The galley is well appointed, featuring a full-size four-ring gas cooker and oven, a 12v fridge/freezer, and a stainless steel sink with drainer. A generous amount of worktop space, cupboards, and drawers ensure there's ample room for all your cooking essentials, making this a functional space whether preparing a quick breakfast or a hearty meal after a day's cruise.

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Forward of the galley sits the bright and comfortable dinette and saloon area. The L-shaped dinette easily converts into a double bed, providing additional sleeping space for guests. Large windows bring in plenty of natural light, while a 12v TV and built-in storage make this a great spot to relax, dine, or unwind after a day on the water.

Mustang Sally offers two separate bedrooms, making her a particularly versatile choice for families or those seeking extra space. The second bedroom can be arranged with two single beds or one double, and could just as easily be repurposed into a secondary seating area, study, or storage room depending on your needs. The main bedroom offers a comfortable sleeping area with generous built-in storage, providing all the essentials for liveaboard life or extended cruising.

With her solid construction, recent refurbishments, and flexible two-bedroom layout, Mustang Sally is equally suited to those seeking a dependable long-term cruiser or a cosy floating home. She represents excellent value and offers everything you need to embark on your next adventure afloat.
