Navy Dancer is a charming and characterful 50ft traditional narrowboat offering a wonderful balance of classic craftsmanship and thoughtful modern updates. Built in 1995 by Delph Marine with a Geoffrey Priest fit-out, she retains the solid feel and timeless appeal of boats from this era, while benefitting from improvements designed for comfortable modern living.

The traditional stern features an extra-wide rear hatch, giving the space an almost semi-trad feel. This clever design creates a sociable and practical stern area, comfortably accommodating two people — and even a four-legged companion — making it ideal for relaxed cruising, steering in all weather, or enjoying a peaceful evening on the water.

Navy Dancer has previously been used as a liveaboard and is well suited to both full-time living and leisure cruising. With two solar panels and a Victron 1.6kW combi inverter/charger, she is set up for off-grid life, providing independence and flexibility for extended stays away from marinas.

Recent improvements include a newly laid floor throughout, bringing a fresh and tidy feel to the interior, alongside the addition of a

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new clic-clac sofa bed in the saloon, adding both comfort and practical sleeping space. The bathroom has also been modernised with a mini dual bath/shower, sink, and storage cabinet — a rare and desirable feature in a boat of this size.

While already comfortable and functional, Navy Dancer offers an excellent opportunity for a new owner to add their own personal touches and light cosmetic improvements, unlocking her full potential as a beautiful home afloat or adventure-ready cruiser.
