Description

Riverdancer is a charming 57ft semi-traditional stern narrowboat, built in 2003 by Heritage Boats, offering a bright, welcoming interior and a practical layout ideal for relaxed canal cruising or extended stays on the water.

Entering from the stern, the boat flows thoughtfully from bedroom to bathroom, galley and lounge, creating a comfortable living space that balances functionality with cosy character.

The master bedroom features a small double bed with useful storage beneath, where the calorifier (new in 2021) is neatly housed. Overhead cupboards provide additional storage and contain the inverter and electrical systems, making efficient use of the space.

Moving forward, the boat benefits from a separate toilet and bathroom arrangement, offering added convenience. The toilet compartment is fitted with a pump-out macerator toilet, while the bathroom includes a basin and an over-bath shower, providing everything needed for comfortable onboard living.

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The L-shaped galley kitchen is well equipped for cooking while cruising. It includes a Thetford oven and grill, four-burner hob, 12v fridge, and a washing machine neatly positioned beneath the sink cupboard, along with eye-level cupboards and generous storage for provisions and cookware.

At the bow, the light and airy lounge creates a welcoming space to relax after a day on the water. It features a sofa bed (new from Sofa Bed Barn in January 2020) allowing additional sleeping accommodation, along with a 12v TV cupboard and shelving unit for entertainment and storage.

Powered by a reliable Beta 38hp engine paired with a PRM 120 gearbox, Riverdancer offers smooth and dependable cruising performance on the inland waterways.

Lovingly maintained and thoughtfully equipped, Riverdancer is a wonderful example of a well-kept narrowboat, perfectly suited to leisurely canal journeys, holiday adventures, or peaceful life afloat.
