Silver Lining is a striking 60ft x 12.5ft Collingwood Euro Cruiser offering stylish widebeam living with generous accommodation, contemporary finishes, and impressive onboard versatility. Built in 2021 and thoughtfully fitted out by the previous owner, this spacious vessel has been designed to combine modern comfort with practical liveaboard functionality, making her equally suited for residential use, long-term cruising, or luxury leisure escapes. Stepping aboard, the large stern deck immediately creates a welcoming outdoor entertaining space, complete with pram cover and deck lighting for comfortable evenings on the water. Inside, the open-plan living arrangement gives the boat a bright and spacious atmosphere, with the galley flowing seamlessly into the saloon to create a sociable central living area. The fully fitted galley has been designed with both practicality and style in mind, featuring solid worktops, integrated appliances, and ample storage throughout. A slimline integrated dishwasher, integrated washing/dryer machine, 12V Shoreline fridge and separate under-counter freezer provide residential convenience, while the five-hob range cooker and extractor hood make cooking onboard effortless. The breakfast bar with four stools offers an ideal casual dining space while also helping to define the kitchen from the lounge area. The saloon is warm, modern, and comfortable, centred around a Saltfire Peanut wood-burning stove which adds character and cosy warmth throughout the colder months. The large L-shaped sofa

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bed provides additional sleeping accommodation, allowing Silver Lining to comfortably sleep up to six people. Fully fitted shelving and cupboards offer excellent storage, while intimate over-counter lighting, a black glass coffee table, 44-inch TV, radiator, and aerial point complete the contemporary feel. A second cabin provides exceptional flexibility and can function equally well as a guest bedroom, office, or hobby space. Fitted with a sofa bed, foldable office desk, office chair, and radiator, it is perfectly suited to modern remote working lifestyles or accommodating visiting guests. The master bedroom is spacious and beautifully appointed, featuring a king-size bed with a large lift-up storage area beneath, fitted wardrobes, overhead cupboards, bedside tables, and a solid wood dressing table area.
