The master bedroom provides a cosy retreat, featuring a fixed double bed with storage beneath, overhead lockers, a wardrobe, and additional drawer space—perfect for keeping everything neatly organised.

Moving forward, the bathroom is well-equipped with a cassette toilet, a shower with an automatic wastewater pump, and a vanity unit with basin. A mirrored wall cabinet, built-in shelving, and cupboard storage complete this practical and tidy space.

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The galley is thoughtfully laid out with everything you need for life onboard, including a 12v fridge with ice box and a gas hob, grill, and oven (new in 2022). Ample storage is complemented by two attractive glass-fronted display units, adding both character and functionality.

The saloon is warm and inviting, lined with oak ply to the ceiling and cabin sides, creating a cosy, traditional feel. A double sofa bed offers additional sleeping space, while a fold-down table and two stools provide flexibility for dining or entertaining.

A charming squirrel multi-fuel stove adds both warmth and atmosphere, making this a perfect space to relax year-round. Built-in corner units and additional storage under the bow steps ensure there’s a place for everything onboard.

A useful corridor storage cupboard adds extra practicality, while the bow well deck offers further storage beneath the steps—ideal for cruising essentials.
